

Eagles Have Baseball Blues

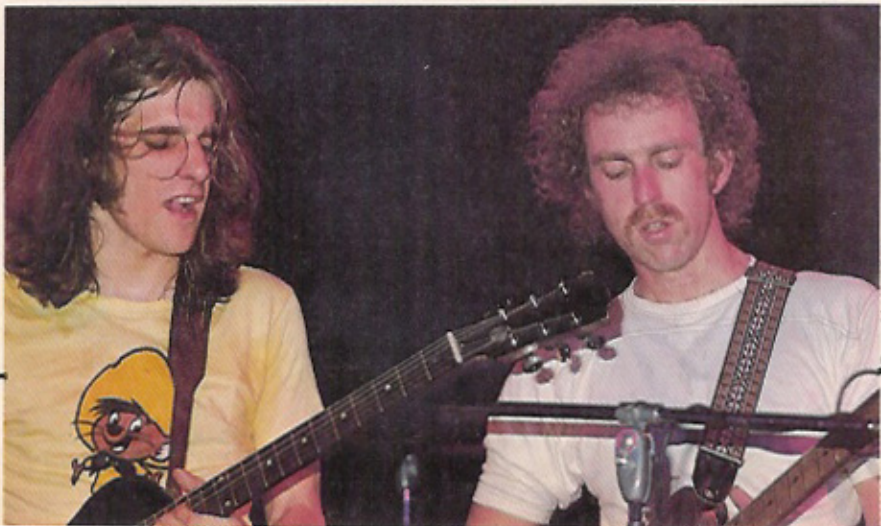
